There will be a Workshop on **FRIDAY** on the construction and assembly of **Gladiolus** – Participants will have materials to complete **FOUR – (4) GLADS** on stems 18 inches to 30 inches long. These ‘new’ flowers are beautiful – long, graceful lines of color with 4-5 ‘blooms’ on each stem – *We’ve also developed another easier, interesting way to contrive IRIS; The materials are totally different – as is the technique to ‘curl’ them – all can be done with no prior prep time or wait time – we’re very proud and happy to introduce another creative way to contrive different flowers -- we will be offering this Workshop on **Friday**. You’ll be able to make **FOUR (4) Iris**. Please check the Workshop time of your choice. Please be aware – all are seated on a **First Registered, First Paid** basis.
